HIGHLIGHTS

Orlando Location:

The Central Florida Dreamplex is proud to have opened a 2nd location in northern Orlando, FL at the start of 2020. Programs currently offered at this location include traditional therapies, Dreamplex Therapeutic School For Hearing & Speech, and the Thrive Resource Center for those who are deaf or hard of hearing.

Glow Together:

Due to the pandemic, a virtual fundraiser was held in lieu of our spring event and annual Gala. During Dreamplex 2020: Glow Together, we saw families come together virtually to learn, donate, and dance. Over \$15,000 was raised to provide scholarships, adaptive sports equipment, accessible rental facilities, and adaptive sports instructors.

Adaptive Hike:

Through partnerships with GRIT Freedom Chair, Tracked Mobility, and FAAST, Inc. the Adaptive Hike program was initiated to provide a new experience using all-terrain wheelchairs for those with physical and intellectual disabilities. Two hikes were held in Fall 2020 and more are scheduled for 2021. This outdoor activity gave people an opportunity to enjoy time with family and friends.

GOALS FOR 2021

Orlando Programs:

There are plans to initiate recreational classes, expand the Dreamplex Therapeutic School for Deaf and Hard of Hearing, and establish a vocational rehab program, all at the Dreamplex Orlando location.

Recreational Opportunities:

In addition to our adaptive hikes, outdoor recreational opportunities will be expanded, possibly including disc golf and sailing. Outdoor sports clinics, such as soccer and football, will also resume.

Electronic Medical Records

The Central Florida Dreamplex will finalize the implementation of EMR software, allowing for quick and easy transferring of individual records between our site and other healthcare providers. This seamless interaction will make for a smooth customer experience while providing our therapists with all necessary patient information.

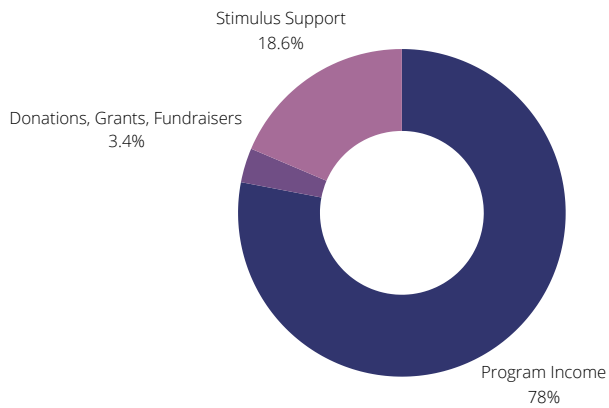

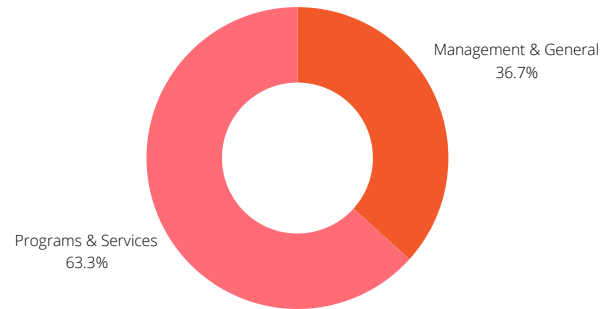

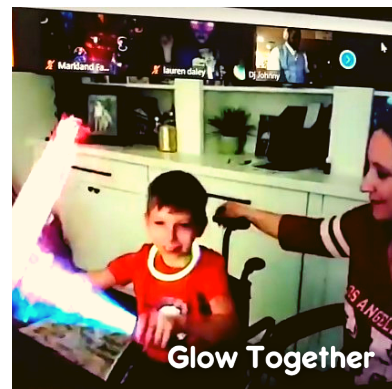
